You may bring a snack to share with the group if you want. Donations are appreciated. There is a limit of 18 participants for this class. Please register by calling the library at 419-644-2771.

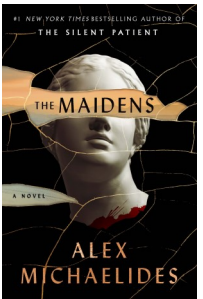
Date Night Book Club

Family Fun: Easter Sock Bunny

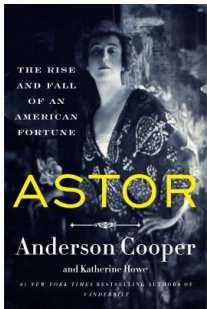

Wednesday, March 27; 2pm-3pm

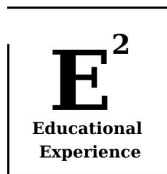
